

Physical Agility Test

Candidates for Dual Role Fire/EMS membership will be required to complete a physical agility test during the probationary period. This test is used to determine if the candidate has the physical strength needed to carry out tasks associated with firefighting. It is also used to determine if the candidate is able to work at heights and in enclosed spaces.

1. Ladder Climb - The candidate will climb the 75' aerial ladder.
The aerial will be fully extended at a 70⁰ angle.
2. Mask Crawl - The candidate will crawl 20' following a rope or hoseline.
The candidate will wear a blacked out SCBA facepiece.
3. Equipment Carry - The candidate will carry an exhaust fan a distance of 50'.
4. Hose Pull - The candidate will place a 1 3/4" charged hoseline over their shoulder and drag the hose 50'. The candidate will stop and drag the remaining 50' of hose to them.
5. Equipment Pull - The candidate will hoist a 50' section of 2.5" hose with a rope and pulley.
6. Equipment Lift - The candidate will simulate using a rotary power saw on a vertical surface at head level.

Tests 1 & 2 are mandatory. The Membership Committee has the option of selecting any two of the remaining tests.
